Pam Houston is an award-winning author, professor, and Colorado rancher whose books include:

- Her best-selling debut novel, *Cowboys are My Weakness*.
- *Deep Creek, Finding Hope in the High Country*, a tender and funny memoir, and profound meditation on bonding with nature and neighbors at her high-country ranch.
- *Air Mail: Letters of Politics, Pandemics and Place*, her newest title and a tribute to both wilderness and a friendship that developed during COVID times.

Jeri L. Norgren is a fifth-generation Coloradan and author of the beautifully illustrated and impeccably researched new book *Colorado's Highest: The History of Naming the 14,000-Foot Peaks*. Ms. Norgren collaborated with the well-known Colorado photographer John Fielder, and the artist Robert L. Wogrin who contributed oil paintings and sketches reproduced in the book. *Colorado's Highest* combines a fascinating historical narrative, with ravishing views of each of the 58 Colorado fourteeners.
