

Improving, Funding, Volunteering

STEM DAY will be our November Branch Meeting. It's scheduled for November 1 at Hillside Community Center where we held it last year. This will be our third annual event.

Last year we received rave reviews from students, teachers, administrators and our own volunteers. Our two major improvements this year will be to replace the math program with wind generators put on by Catamount Institute and to hold all but four classes upstairs where it will be quieter than last year. Gretchen Hein has coordinated Catamount Institute's involvement.

A major challenge we have this year is funding. High-Tech, High Heels has been a major supporter in the past but disbanded this year. We are still applying for grants. However, most of the ones we are eligible for fund their grants in December. To meet this emergency, we will set out a donation box on the STEM table at the Welcome Coffee September 21st. Today we are down about \$1500. If anyone has an idea of some business which might be interested in providing us with a donation of \$200 or so, please contact me at Mfrydrych@comcast.net.

As always there will be lots of openings for volunteers. I'll be sending out a survey to last year's volunteers asking for ways to improve training. I'm hoping to include responses in the upcoming training October 28 at Colorado Technical University.
